

Complaint about childcare provision

Summary of outcome

All early years providers must meet the legal requirements in the Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage, which you can find at www.gov.uk/government/publications/early-years-foundation-stage-framework--2. If we find that a provider is not meeting the requirements, we can take action to ensure they put matters right

On 15 June 2023, we received concerns that the provider was not meeting some of these requirements.

On 23 June 2023, we carried out a regulatory telephone call. We found the provider was not meeting some of the requirements and had taken action to put this right. The provider took immediate steps to review and revise arrangements for the safe collection and arrival of children. Staff have also received additional clarity about their roles and responsibilities to ensure children are appropriately supervised at all times. The practice is monitored by the manager to ensure it is embedded.

The provider will be able to give parents further information about this.

The provider remains registered with Ofsted.
