

Compliance action taken for childcare provision

Summary of outcome

All early years providers must meet the legal requirements in the Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage, which you can find at www.gov.uk/government/publications/early-years-foundation-stage-framework--2. If we find that a provider is not meeting the requirements, we can take action to ensure they put matters right.

On 13 June 2023, the provider notified us of a significant incident. The notification means that the provider met their legal responsibility as set out in the Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage to notify Ofsted of a significant event.

On 23 June 2023, we carried out a regulatory telephone call. We found the provider was not meeting some of the requirements. We have issued actions for the provider to take. The provider will be able to give parents further information about this. Actions needed by 6 July 2023:

■ make sure information gathered from parents about children's specific dietary needs is appropriately acted on to ensure children's individual health needs are always met.

On 5 July 2023, the provider responded to the action set. We found that the provider had reinforced procedures to ensure staff use all the information they gather about children's dietary needs to meet their health needs. The preparation of all meals is undertaken by the nursery chef who is trained to ensure the appropriate use of equipment. Staff received additional training on following health and safety polices. The provider also increased the arrangements to monitor practice by senior staff throughout the day, to ensure health and safety procedures are successfully implemented. The provider will be able to give parents further information about this.



The provider remains registered with Ofsted.

Publication of compliance action

We aim to ensure that the welfare of children and young people is protected in the services we regulate. The Childcare Act 2006 and accompanying regulations set out our responsibilities to regulate childminders and childcare providers. This includes the enforcement powers we have in relation to those registered providers who do not comply with the requirements for registration.

We publish details of any actions we take, or the childminder or childcare provider takes to bring about compliance with requirements on our website for a period of five years.
