

Compliance action taken for childcare provision

Summary of outcome

All early years providers must meet the legal requirements in the Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage, which you can find at www.gov.uk/government/publications/early-years-foundation-stage-framework--2. If we find that a provider is not meeting the requirements, we can take action to ensure they put matters right.

On 19 July 2023, we carried out a regulatory visit. We found the provider was not meeting some of the requirements. We have issued actions for the provider to take. The provider will be able to give parents further information about this.

Actions needed by 2 August 2023:

- ensure that all reasonable steps are taken to demonstrate how risks are being managed and identified, in order to prevent significant accidents occurring on site

- provide Ofsted with the necessary information so that the required checks can be completed on new members of the committee, to confirm their suitability.

On the 8 August 2023, the provider responded to the actions set. They have developed a reporting process for significant incidents to ensure that should an incident occur in the future, there are clear systems in place to manage and identify associated risks. All staff have been trained in this process to ensure they are fully aware of how to prevent significant accidents and how to deal with them appropriately should they arise. Additionally, the provider has ensured that all the appropriate information has been shared with Ofsted to ensure checks can be completed to affirm their suitability.

The provider remains registered with Ofsted.

Publication of compliance action

We aim to ensure that the welfare of children and young people is protected in the services we regulate. The Childcare Act 2006 and accompanying regulations set out our responsibilities to regulate childminders and childcare providers. This includes the enforcement powers we have in relation to those registered providers who do not comply with the requirements for registration.
