

## **Compliance action taken for childcare provision**

### **Summary of outcome**

All early years providers must meet the legal requirements in the Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage, which you can find at [www.gov.uk/government/publications/early-years-foundation-stage-framework--2](http://www.gov.uk/government/publications/early-years-foundation-stage-framework--2). If we find that a provider is not meeting the requirements, we can take action to ensure they put matters right.

On 11 July 2023 we received concerns that the provider was not meeting some of these requirements.

On 26 July 2023, we carried out a regulatory visit. We found the provider was not meeting some of the requirements. We issued an action for the provider to take. The provider will be able to give parents further information about this.

Action needed by 10 August 2023

- ensure that at least half of all staff have received training that specifically addresses the care of babies.

On 5 August 2023, the provider responded to the action set. All staff working with babies have been provided with time to attend an online training course to support their work with babies. Additionally, other staff working with older children have also attended training in the care of babies.

We will monitor the provider's response to ensure the actions are successfully completed. The provider is still registered with Ofsted.

### **Publication of compliance action**

We aim to ensure that the welfare of children and young people is protected in the services we regulate. The Childcare Act 2006 and accompanying regulations set out our responsibilities to regulate childminders and childcare providers. This includes the enforcement powers we have in relation to those registered providers who do not comply with the requirements for registration.

We publish details of any actions we take, or the childminder or childcare provider takes to bring about compliance with requirements on our website for a period of five years.
