

## **Compliance action taken for childcare provision**

### **Summary of outcome**

All early years providers must meet the legal requirements in the Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage, which you can find at [www.gov.uk/government/publications/early-years-foundation-stage-framework--2](http://www.gov.uk/government/publications/early-years-foundation-stage-framework--2). If we find that a provider is not meeting the requirements, we can take action to ensure they put matters right.

On 19 July 2023, the provider notified us of a serious accident. The notification means that the provider met their legal responsibility as set out in the Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage to notify Ofsted of significant events.

On 31 July 2023, we carried out a regulatory telephone call. We found the provider was not meeting some of the requirements. We have issued actions for the provider to take below within the timescales set.

Actions needed by 25 August 2023:

make sure all relevant agencies are notified of serious accidents and/or injuries that occur in the setting, including local authority children's services

provide staff with appropriate support and training to fully understand all of their roles and responsibilities, including managing health and safety issues related to the handling of various materials and cleaning up of different spills.

On 12 August 2023, the provider responded to the actions set. We found that the provider has contacted all relevant agencies to make sure they are notified of the recent serious accident. A review of the setting's cleaning equipment has been conducted and new activity specific risk assessment procedures implemented. The provider has enrolled staff on varying training courses to improve their understanding of handling various materials and managing spills related to these.

We are satisfied the provider has met the safeguarding and welfare actions raised. The provider is still registered with Ofsted.

### **Publication of compliance action**

We aim to ensure that the welfare of children and young people is protected in the services we regulate. The Childcare Act 2006 and accompanying regulations set out our

responsibilities to regulate childminders and childcare providers. This includes the enforcement powers we have in relation to those registered providers who do not comply with the requirements for registration.

We publish details of any actions we take, or the childminder or childcare provider takes to bring about compliance with requirements on our website for a period of five years.
