

Complaint about childcare provision

Summary of outcome

All early years providers must meet the legal requirements in the Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage, which you can find at www.gov.uk/government/publications/early-years-foundation-stage-framework--2.

If we find that a provider is not meeting the requirements, we can take action to ensure they put matters right.

On 11th and 12th July 2023, the provider notified us of two significant events. The notification means that the provider met their legal responsibility as set out in the Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage to notify Ofsted of any significant event which is likely to affect the suitability of the early years

provider or any person who cares for, or is in regular contact with, children on

the premises to look after children.

On 01st August 2023, we carried out a regulatory visit. We found the provider was not meeting some of the requirements. We have issued actions for the provider to take.

The provider will be able to give parents further information about this. The provider is still registered with Ofsted.

Actions needed by 11th September 2023:

¿ improve all staff's understanding of the whistleblowing procedure and ensure they report all concerns swiftly.

We will monitor the provider's response to ensure the action is successfully completed.



On 21 August 2023, the provider responded to the action set. We found that the provider had improved staff's knowledge and understanding of child protection procedures and now fully understands their responsibilities. We are satisfied the provider has met the safeguarding and welfare actions raised. The provider is still registered with Ofsted.
