

Compliance action taken for childcare provision

Summary of outcome

All early years providers must meet the legal requirements in the Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage, which you can find at www.gov.uk/government/publications/early-years-foundation-stage-framework--2. If we find that a provider is not meeting the requirements, we can take action to ensure they put matters right.

On 29 August 2023, the provider notified Ofsted about an incident. This notification means the provider has met their legal responsibility as set out in the Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage, to notify Ofsted of a significant event.

On 15 September 2023, we carried out a regulatory visit. During the visit, we found the provider was not meeting some of the requirements but had taken action to put this right. The provider had taken action to strengthen the supervision and safety of children. They provided refresher training for staff to ensure they are able to implement the nursery's procedures. Risk assessments have been improved to ensure that staff deployment is effective. Staff have been issued with updated policies and have been re trained in how to ensure all children are kept within sight and/or hearing. The provider has reissued the safeguarding procedures. This includes the whistle-blowing policy so that any concerns can be reported to agencies with statutory responsibilities without delay.

The provider will be able to give parents further information about this. The provider is still registered with Ofsted.

Publication of compliance action

We aim to ensure that the welfare of children and young people is protected in the services we regulate. The Childcare Act 2006 and accompanying regulations set out our responsibilities to regulate childminders and childcare providers. This includes the enforcement powers we have in relation to those registered providers who do not comply with the requirements for registration.

We publish details of any actions we take, or the childminder or childcare provider takes to bring about compliance with requirements on our website for a period of five years.
