## **Information about this children's home**

This secure home is operated by a voluntary organisation and is approved by the Secretary of State to restrict children's liberty. The home provides care for up to 12 children aged between 10 and 17 who are placed by local authorities and accommodated under section 25 of the Children Act 1989.

Admission of any young person under section 25 of the Children Act 1989 who is under 13 years of age requires the approval of the Secretary of State.

The commissioning of health services in this home is the statutory responsibility of NHS England under the Health and Social Care Act 2012. Education is provided on site in dedicated facilities.

The manager is registered with Ofsted and has managed the home since July 2022.

This visit was carried out in line with the memorandum of understanding between Ofsted and the Department for Education (DfE).

The inspector visited the home with a specialist architect commissioned by the DfE to review major refurbishment works. Work to the kitchens and other areas has been completed to a good standard that will benefit children.
