

Complaint about childcare provision

Summary of outcome

All early years providers must meet the legal requirements in the Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage, which you can find at www.gov.uk/government/publications/early-years-foundation-stage-framework--2. If we find that a provider is not meeting the requirements, we can take action to ensure they put matters right.

On 8 August 2023, we received concerns that the provider was not meeting some of these requirements. On 6 September 2023, we carried out a regulatory visit. We found the provider was not meeting some of the requirements. We have issued actions for the provider to take.

Actions needed by 25 September 2023:

- ensure all staff implement agreed risk assessment procedures and take immediate action to rectify any concerns and minimise hazards.

On 21 September 2023, the provider responded to the action set. We found that the provider has taken steps to improve staffs knowledge of risk assessment procedures and there are systems in place to ensure that these are implemented consistently. We are satisfied that the provider has met the action set. The provider is still registered with Ofsted.

We publish details of complaints made against childminders, home childcarers and childcare providers where we or the provider have taken action in order to meet legal requirements.
