

Complaint about childcare provision

Summary of outcome

All early years providers must meet the legal requirements in the Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage, which you can find at www.gov.uk/government/publications/early-years-foundation-stage-framework--2. If we find that a provider is not meeting the requirements, we can take action to ensure they put matters right.

On 22 Aug 2023, we received concerns that the provider was not meeting some of these requirements.

On 26 September 2023, we carried out a regulatory visit. We found the provider was not meeting some of the requirements.

Actions needed by 210 October 2023.

- implement a robust, ongoing risk assessment process, so that hazards are identified and minimised to keep children safe.

On 13 October 2023, the provider responded to the action set. We found that the provider had improved their knowledge and understanding of risk assessment procedures and now fully understands their responsibilities. We are satisfied the provider has met the safeguarding and welfare actions raised. The provider is still registered with Ofsted.

Publication of complaints

We publish details of complaints made against childminders, home childcarers and childcare providers where we or the provider have taken action in order to meet legal requirements.
