

Compliance action taken for childcare provision

Summary of outcome

All early years providers must meet the legal requirements in the Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage, which you can find at www.gov.uk/government/publications/early-years-foundation-stage-framework--2.

If we find that a provider is not meeting the requirements, we can take action to ensure they put matters right.

On 22 September 2023, the provider notified us of a significant event. The notification means that the provider met their legal responsibility as set out in the Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage to notify Ofsted of a significant event.

On 28 September 2023, we carried out a regulatory telephone call. We found the provider was not meeting some of the requirements. We issued actions for the provider to take. The provider will be able to give parents further information about this.

Action needed by 09 October 2023:

■ ensure a written record is maintained of all accidents or injuries a child sustains whilst in your care, including first aid treatment. In addition, ensure that parents are informed promptly of accidents or injuries and first aid treatment administered to their child.

On 10 October 2023, the provider responded to the action set. We found that the provider has taken steps to re-train staff in specific aspects of first aid procedures. Procedures have been reviewed to ensure parents are informed of significant accidents and injuries.

We are satisfied the provider has met the safeguarding and welfare action raised. The



provider is still registered with Ofsted.

Publication of compliance action

We aim to ensure that the welfare of children and young people is protected in the services we regulate. The Childcare Act 2006 and accompanying regulations set out our responsibilities to regulate childminders and childcare providers. This includes the enforcement powers we have in relation to those registered providers who do not comply with the requirements for registration.

We publish details of any actions we take, or the childminder or childcare provider takes to bring about compliance with requirements on our website for a period of five years.
