

Compliance action taken for childcare provision

Summary of outcome

All early years providers must meet the legal requirements in the Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage, which you can find at www.gov.uk/government/publications/early-years-foundation-stage-framework--2. If we find that a provider is not meeting the requirements, we can take action to ensure they put matters right.

On 22 August 2023, we carried out an inspection and found the provider was not meeting some of these requirements. The overall effectiveness of the provision was judged to be inadequate. The inspection report sets out the actions the provider was required to take to meet the requirements.

On 18 September 2023, we carried out a regulatory visit. The focus of the visit was to check whether the provider had met the safeguarding and welfare actions, raised at their last inspection.

On 18 September 2023, the provider responded to the actions set. We found that the provider had made the premises secure to prevent unauthorised persons entering and had procedures in place to effectively supervise children. There are appropriate measures in place for the safe use of mobile phones. Staff have suitable knowledge of safeguarding issues and know the procedures to follow to report any child protection concerns. Staff understand how to manage children's behaviour in an appropriate way. There is an effective key person system in place which ensures that staff have sufficient knowledge and understanding of each child and their needs. There is a two-way flow of information with parents and other settings where children attend to obtain necessary information and help meet every child's needs. Appropriate arrangements are in place for the supervision of all staff. We are satisfied the provider has met the safeguarding and welfare actions raised. The provider is still registered with Ofsted.
