

Compliance action taken for childcare provision

Summary of outcome

All early years providers must meet the legal requirements in the Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage, which you can find at www.gov.uk/government/publications/early-years-foundation-stage-framework--2. If we find that a provider is not meeting the requirements, we can take action to ensure they put matters right.

On 4 October 2023, we carried out an inspection and found out that the provider was not meeting some of these requirements. The overall effectiveness of the provision was judged to be inadequate. The inspection report sets out the actions the provider was required to take to meet the requirements.

On 3 November 2022, we carried out a regulatory visit. The focus of the visit was to check whether the provider had met the safeguarding and welfare actions, raised at their last inspection.

We found that the provider has taken steps to ensure that staff have up to date knowledge of safeguarding matters, including reporting procedures in line with the local safeguarding partners. The provider has improved oversight of the setting to ensure that leaders meet the responsibilities of their roles and that staff receive the support they need to improve their practice. The provider has taken steps to ensure that staff receive effective training and support to help them understand their roles and responsibilities and to improve the quality of education for all children. The key-person approach is consistently used to effectively meet children's individual needs and to build relationship with their parents. The provider ensures that consistent strategies for managing children's behaviour are being embedded by staff so that children have a clear understanding of appropriate boundaries and expectations. The provider ensures that staff implement effective risk assessment and good hygiene practices to promote children's good health and well-being.

We are satisfied the provider has met the safeguarding and welfare actions raised. The provider is still registered with Ofsted.
