

Compliance action taken for childcare provision

Summary of outcome

All early years providers must meet the legal requirements in the Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage, which you can find at www.gov.uk/government/publications/early-years-foundation-stage-framework--2. If we find that a provider is not meeting the requirements, we can take action to ensure they put matters right.

On 14 September 2023, we carried out an inspection and found the provider was not meeting some of these requirements. The overall effectiveness of the provision was judged to be inadequate. The inspection report sets out the actions the provider was required to take to meet the requirements.

On 10 October 2023, we carried out a regulatory visit to monitor the actions set at inspection. We found the provider had taken suitable steps to address the actions. However, during the visit, we identified an additional breach of requirements. We served a welfare requirements notice. This is a legal notice that requires the provider to take the actions below within the timescales set out.

Actions needed by 24 October 2023:

ensure that allegations made against staff are correctly identified and suitable action is taken in line with the local safeguarding partnership.

On 2 November 2023, after further discussions with the provider, they responded to the action set. We found that the provider had improved their knowledge and understanding of allegation procedures and have taken suitable action. We are satisfied the provider has met the safeguarding and welfare action raised. The provider is still registered with Ofsted.
