

Compliance action taken for childcare provision

Summary of outcome

All early years providers must meet the legal requirements in the Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage, which you can find at www.gov.uk/government/publications/early-years-foundation-stage-framework--2. If we find that a provider is not meeting the requirements, we can take action to ensure they put matters right.

On 26 Sept 2023, we carried out an inspection and found the provider was not meeting some of these requirements. The overall effectiveness of the provision was judged to be inadequate. The inspection report sets out the actions the provider was required to take to meet the requirements.

On 17 Oct 2023, we carried out a regulatory visit. The focus of the visit was to check whether the provider had met the safeguarding and welfare actions raised at their last inspection.

On 17 Oct 2023, the provider responded to the actions set. We found that the provider had reviewed all risk assessments and removed broken and dangerous equipment. Leaders and managers had improved staff deployment and the organisation of daily routines to meet the needs of all children. They had improved arrangements for supervisions to ensure staff are effective in their roles. We are satisfied the provider has met the safeguarding and welfare actions raised. The provider is still registered with Ofsted.
