

## Compliance action taken for childcare provision

## Summary of outcome

All early years providers must meet the legal requirements in the Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage, which you can find at www.gov.uk/government/publications/early-years-foundation-stage-framework--2. If we find that a provider is not meeting the requirements, we can take action to ensure they put matters right.

On 8 November 2023, the provider notified us of an incident relating to the management of children's dietary needs. The notification mean that the provider met their legal responsibility as set out in the Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage to notify Ofsted of significant events.

On 22 November 2023, we carried out a regulatory telephone call. We found the provider was not meeting some of the requirements and had taken action to put this right.

The provider has conducted a thorough investigation into the incident. The provider has offered retraining for the entire management and staff team regarding management of children's dietary needs in line with their expected processes. The national early years specialist for the organisation has attended the provision and conducted observations of mealtimes. Furthermore, the provider has sent their company health and safety monitor to the provision to check how snack and mealtime processes are working in practice. The provision manager now has the responsibility to closely monitor these practices to ensure improvements are embedded.

The provider will be able to give parents further information about this. The provider is still registered with Ofsted.

## **Publication of compliance action**

We aim to ensure that the welfare of children and young people is protected in the services we regulate. The Childcare Act 2006 and accompanying regulations set out our responsibilities to regulate childminders and childcare providers. This includes the enforcement powers we have in relation to those registered providers who do not comply with the requirements for registration.

We publish details of any actions we take, or the childminder or childcare provider takes to bring about compliance with requirements on our website for a period of five years.
