

## **Compliance action taken for childcare provision**

### **Summary of outcome**

All early years providers must meet the legal requirements in the Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage, which you can find at [www.gov.uk/government/publications/early-years-foundation-stage-framework--2](https://www.gov.uk/government/publications/early-years-foundation-stage-framework--2). If we find that a provider is not meeting the requirements, we can take action to ensure they put matters right.

On 10 August 2023, the provider notified us about an outbreak of sickness. On 22 September 2023, the provider notified us about a significant incident relating to children's health. On 17 November 2023, the provider notified us of significant event relating to meeting children's dietary needs. The notifications mean that the provider met their legal responsibility as set out in the Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage to notify Ofsted of significant events.

On 1 December 2023, we carried out a regulatory telephone call. We found the provider was not meeting some of the requirements and had taken appropriate action to put this right. The provider reviewed and strengthened the procedures to support children with specific dietary needs. Staff have received further training on their specific roles and responsibilities when supervising mealtimes to keep children safe. Managers have monitored staff practice to ensure the procedures are vigilantly followed to protect children's health needs.

The provider will be able to give parents further information about this.

The provider is still registered with Ofsted.

### **Publication of compliance action**

We aim to ensure that the welfare of children and young people is protected in the services we regulate. The Childcare Act 2006 and accompanying regulations set out our responsibilities to regulate childminders and childcare providers. This includes the

enforcement powers we have in relation to those registered providers who do not comply with the requirements for registration.

We publish details of any actions we take, or the childminder or childcare provider takes to bring about compliance with requirements on our website for a period of five years.
