

Complaint about childcare provision

Summary of outcome

All early years providers must meet the legal requirements in the Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage, which you can find at www.gov.uk/government/publications/early-years-foundation-stage-framework. If we find that a provider is not meeting the requirements, we can take action to ensure they put matters right.

On 8 December 2023, we received concerns that the provider was not meeting some of these requirements.

On 8 December 2023, we carried out a regulatory telephone call. We found the provider was not meeting some of the requirements in relation to risk assessment. A child had suffered a significant injury while in the care of the nursery. Following the accident, the manager has taken action to prevent this happening again. She has obtained a anti slip mat to place under equipment to reduce the risk of equipment being pulled or moved by children. Equipment wires have also been shortened to prevent children being able to reach and pull on them.

The provider will be able to give parents further information about this. The provider is still registered with Ofsted.
