

## **Compliance action taken for childcare provision**

### **Summary of outcome**

All early years providers must meet the legal requirements in the Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage, which you can find at [www.gov.uk/government/publications/early-years-foundation-stage-framework--2](http://www.gov.uk/government/publications/early-years-foundation-stage-framework--2). If we find that a provider is not meeting the requirements, we can take action to ensure they put matters right.

On 13 November 2023, the provider notified us that an incident occurred regarding the inappropriate management of children's behaviour. The notification means that the provider met their legal responsibility as set out in the Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage to notify Ofsted of a significant event.

On 4 December 2023, we carried out a regulatory telephone call. We found the provider was not meeting one of the requirements and had taken action to put this right. The provider has reiterated behaviour management procedures with the staff to ensure children's behaviour is managed in an appropriate way.

We also found that the provider was not meeting a further requirement. We have issued an action for the provider to take. The provider will be able to give parents further information about this.

Action needed by 5 January 2023 to:

ensure policies and procedures are followed to safeguard children when there are concerns about adults who work with the children.

We will monitor the provider's response to ensure the action is successfully completed.

The provider is still registered with Ofsted.

### **Publication of compliance action**

We aim to ensure that the welfare of children and young people is protected in the services we regulate. The Childcare Act 2006 and accompanying regulations set out our responsibilities to regulate childminders and childcare providers. This includes the enforcement powers we have in relation to those registered providers who do not comply with the requirements for registration.

We publish details of any actions we take, or the childminder or childcare provider takes to bring about compliance with requirements on our website for a period of five years.
