

## **Complaint about childcare provision**

### **Summary of outcome**

All early years providers must meet the legal requirements in the Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage, which you can find at [www.gov.uk/government/publications/early-years-foundation-stage-framework--2](http://www.gov.uk/government/publications/early-years-foundation-stage-framework--2). If we find that a provider is not meeting the requirements, we can take action to ensure they put matters right.

On 4 January 2024, we received concerns that the provider was not meeting some of these requirements.

On 5 and 9 December 2024, we carried out regulatory telephone calls. We found the provider was not meeting some of the requirements and had taken action to put this right. Staff now write children's full names on their lunchboxes and check with another member of staff before giving children packed lunches they bring in from home. There is also a board for staff to write down exactly which children have brought in their own lunches and those who have lunches provided by the nursery cook. The provider will be able to give parents further information about this.

The provider is still registered with Ofsted.

### **Publication of complaints**
