

## **Compliance action taken for childcare provision**

## **Summary of outcome**

All early years providers must meet the legal requirements in the Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage, which you can find at www.gov.uk/government/publications/early-years-foundation-stage-framework--2. If we find that a provider is not meeting the requirements, we can take action to ensure they put matters right.

On 7 December 2024, we carried out an inspection and found the provider was not meeting some of these requirements.

The overall effectiveness of the provision was judged to be inadequate. The inspection report sets out the actions the provider was required to take to meet the requirements. We served a welfare requirements notice. This is a legal notice that requires the provider to take action within the timescales set out in the inspection report.

On 29 January 2024, we carried out a regulatory visit. The focus of the visit was to check whether the provider had met the safeguarding and welfare actions raised at their last inspection. The provider was not at the premises. On 6 February 2024, we carried out a second regulatory visit. The focus of the visit was to check whether the provider had met the safeguarding and welfare actions raised at their last inspection.

We found that the provider had refreshed their safeguarding knowledge and understanding by completing relevant training. They knew and understood the procedure to follow in the event an allegation is made about themselves or a household member. The provider maintains a daily record of children's attendance. They have systems in place to record upto-date information about children's dietary needs. The provider had strengthened risk assessment processes so that they can quickly identify and address hazards to children. They have engaged with professional development which focuses on children's learning and development.

We are satisfied the provider has met the safeguarding and welfare actions raised. The provider is still registered with Ofsted.
