

Compliance action taken for childcare provision

Summary of outcome

All early years providers must meet the legal requirements in the Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage, which you can find at www.gov.uk/government/publications/early-years-foundation-stage-framework--2. If we find that a provider is not meeting the requirements, we can take action to ensure they put matters right.

On 2 February 2024, we received concerns that the provider was not meeting some of these requirements.

On 7 February 2024, we carried out a regulatory visit. We found the provider was not meeting some of the requirements and had taken action to put this right. The provider has strengthened their oversight of the nursery to ensure that staff:child ratios are always met, and that staff are deployed effectively to ensure children are adequately supervised and their needs are met. The provider followed their performance management procedures to help support leaders to fulfil their roles and responsibilities. They have trained all staff on safeguarding and regularly test out their knowledge and understanding. This helps ensure children are kept safe.

The provider will be able to give parents further information about this. The provider is still registered with Ofsted.

Publication of compliance action

We aim to ensure that the welfare of children and young people is protected in the services we regulate. The Childcare Act 2006 and accompanying regulations set out our responsibilities to regulate childminders and childcare providers. This includes the enforcement powers we have in relation to those registered providers who do not comply with the requirements for registration.

We publish details of any actions we take, or the childminder or childcare provider takes to



bring about compliance with requirements on our website for a period of five years.
