

Compliance action taken for childcare provision

Summary of outcome

All early years providers must meet the legal requirements in the Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage, which you can find at www.gov.uk/government/publications/early-years-foundation-stage-framework--2. If we find that a provider is not meeting the requirements, we can take action to ensure they put matters right.

On 12 December 2023, we carried out an inspection and found the provider was not meeting some of these requirements.

The overall effectiveness of the provision was judged to be inadequate. The inspection report sets out the actions the provider was required to take to meet the requirements.

On 26 January 2024, we carried out a regulatory visit. The focus of the visit was to check whether the provider had met the safeguarding and welfare actions, raised at their last inspection. We found that the provider had improved their knowledge and understanding of child protection procedures and now understands their responsibilities. The provider understands her responsibility to notify Ofsted of matters that might affect her registration. Information has now been provided to enable Ofsted to complete suitability checks on anyone over the age of 16 living on the premises. The provider now also maintains a daily register of children's attendance.

We are satisfied the provider has met the safeguarding and welfare actions raised.

The provider is still registered with Ofsted.
