

Complaint about childcare provision

Summary of outcome

Our reference EY472145/ 5641427

All early years providers must meet the legal requirements in the Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage, which you can find at www.gov.uk/government/publications/early-years-foundation-stage-framework--2. If we find that a provider is not meeting the requirements, we can take action to ensure they put matters right.

On 18 January 2024, we received concerns that the provider was not meeting some of these requirements.

On 26 January 2024, we carried out a regulatory visit. We found the provider was not meeting some of the requirements. We have issued an action for the provider to take. The provider will be able to give parents further information about this.

Action needed by 9 February 2024:

- ensure the designated safeguarding lead follows the correct safeguarding procedures when concerns are raised about a staff member's practice.

On 9 February 2024, the provider responded to the action set. We found that the provider had taken steps to improve staff's knowledge and understanding of safeguarding procedures and the designated safeguarding lead now fully understands their responsibilities.

We are satisfied the provider has met the safeguarding and welfare action raised. The provider is still registered with Ofsted.
