

Complaint about childcare provision

Summary of outcome

All early years providers must meet the legal requirements in the Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage, which you can find at www.gov.uk/government/publications/early-years-foundation-stage-framework--2. If we find that a provider is not meeting the requirements, we can take action to ensure they put matters right.

On 9 January 2024 and 2 February 2024, the provider notified us of two significant incidents. The notification means that the provider met their legal responsibility as set out in the Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage to notify Ofsted.

On 15 February 2024, we carried out a regulatory telephone call. We found the provider was not meeting some of the requirements and had taken action to put this right.

Staff have received additional training regarding risk assessment of space that is available to very young children, to safely support their developing mobility and curiosity. Routine safety discussions at staff meetings have been initiated to increase staff's safety awareness and the identification of areas that may present as a challenge to very young children.

The provider will be able to give parents further information about this. The provider is still registered with Ofsted.
