

Complaint about childcare provision

Summary of outcome

All early years providers must meet the legal requirements in the Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage, which you can find at www.gov.uk/government/publications/early-years-foundation-stage-framework--2. If we find that a provider is not meeting the requirements, we can take action to ensure they put matters right.

On 19 January 2024, we received concerns that the provider was not meeting some of these requirements. On 20 January 2024, the provider notified us of a linked matter relating to children's safety and welfare. The notification means that the provider met their legal responsibility as set out in the Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage to notify Ofsted of any significant event which is likely to affect the suitability of a person who is in regular contact with children on the premises where childcare is provided.

On 04 April 2024, we carried out a regulatory call. We found the provider was not meeting some of the requirements and had taken action to put this right. This includes reviewing safeguarding procedures and re-enforcing expectations of respectful handling of children. Additionally, staff have updated their behaviour management and safeguarding training to support children's safety and welfare within the setting. We are satisfied with the action taken by the provider and therefore no further action is required to be taken by us.

The provider will be able to give parents further information about this. The provider is still registered with Ofsted.
