Summary of key findings

This provision meets requirements

- The childminder expresses her commitment to her professional development. She intends to involve parents to evaluate the quality of her childcare services.
- The childminder has a variety of toys and equipment available. She knows how to observe and assess children's learning to plan the educational programmes.
- The childminder understands how to work with parents and other professionals to promote children's learning. For example, she will discuss with parents how to manage children's behaviour.
- The childminder wants to make use of the outdoor space to support children's physical health. She plans to take children to the local park and playgroups to help raise their social skills.
- The childminder knows how to identify safeguarding concerns and what to do to protect children's welfare. She has procedures in place to check the premises to ensure that children are not exposed to unnecessary risks, including during sleep time.
- The childminder intends to promote equality and diversity through activities and celebrations such as Easter, Diwali and Chinese New Year.

There were no children in the early years age range present when this inspection took place. The findings in this report are based on evidence gathered from discussions with those who care for the children and an inspection of the premises, equipment and relevant documentation. Where there are no early years children present, no judgement is made on the quality of the early years provision as there is no reliable evidence on which to assess its impact on children. The report states whether the provider continues to meet the requirements of registration.

Inspection activities

- The childminder explained to the inspector how she intends to work with parents and other professionals.
- The inspector discussed with the childminder how she intends to undertake observation and assessment to plan the educational programmes for children. She looked at relevant documents, including evidence of the suitability of all persons living at the premises.
