

Compliance action taken for childcare provision

Summary of outcome

All early years providers must meet the legal requirements in the Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage, which you can find at www.gov.uk/government/publications/early-years-foundation-stage-framework--2. If we find that a provider is not meeting the requirements, we can take action to ensure they put matters right.

On 5 March 2024, we received concerns that the provider was not meeting some of these requirements.

On 27 March 2024, we carried out a regulatory visit. We found the provider was not meeting some of the requirements. We issued actions for the provider to take.

Actions needed by 17 April 2024:

- ensure information and records regarding staff are easily accessible and available when requested
- ensure all staff, including managers, have a secure and robust understanding of how to report concerns about children or if an allegation was made against a member of staff, in line with local reporting procedures.

On 17 April 2024, the provider responded to the actions set. We found that the provider had taken appropriate action to ensure information about staff was available and that all staff knew what to do if they had concerns about a child or if an allegation was made against them. The provider had ensured that all staff had undertaken further safeguarding training and had reviewed their safeguarding processes in line with local reporting procedures. Leaders and managers now fully understand their roles and responsibilities.

We are satisfied the provider has met the safeguarding and welfare actions raised. The provider is still registered with Ofsted.

Publication of compliance action

We aim to ensure that the welfare of children and young people is protected in the services we regulate. The Childcare Act 2006 and accompanying regulations set out our

responsibilities to regulate childminders and childcare providers. This includes the enforcement powers we have in relation to those registered providers who do not comply with the requirements for registration.

We publish details of any actions we take, or the childminder or childcare provider takes to bring about compliance with requirements on our website for a period of five years.
