Information about this children's home

This secure home is operated by a local authority and is approved by the Secretary of State to restrict children's liberty. The home provides care for up to 12 children aged between 10 and 17 who are placed by local authorities and accommodated under section 25 of the Children Act 1989. At the time of this visit, five children were living at the home.

Admission of any child under section 25 of the Children Act 1989 who is under 13 years of age requires the approval of the Secretary of State.

The commissioning of health services in this home is the statutory responsibility of NHS England under the Health and Social Care Act 2012. Education is provided on site in dedicated facilities.

The manager registered with Ofsted in August 2023.

This monitoring visit

This visit was carried out in line with the memorandum of understanding between Ofsted and the Department for Education (DfE).

The inspector visited the home with specialist architects commissioned by the DfE to review major refurbishment works. Most works have been completed to a good standard that will benefit children. Some aspects require attention and will be detailed in the report from the specialist architects, which will be sent to the home. When these matters have been addressed, the home must provide evidence to the architect. These areas are not to be used by children until the architect confirms to the home that works have been satisfactorily completed.

The requirement and recommendations made at the last inspection will be reviewed at the next inspection.
