

Compliance action taken for childcare provision

Summary of outcome

All early years providers must meet the legal requirements in the Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage, which you can find at www.gov.uk/government/publications/early-years-foundation-stage-framework--2. If we find that a provider is not meeting the requirements, we can take action to ensure they put matters right.

On 12 March 2024, we carried out an inspection and found the provider was not meeting some of these requirements. The overall effectiveness of the provision was judged to be inadequate. The inspection report sets out the actions the provider was required to take to meet the requirements.

On 3 April 2024, we carried out a regulatory visit. The focus of the visit was to check whether the provider had met the safeguarding and welfare actions raised at their last inspection. We found that the provider has suitable oversight of the nursery. Leaders had provided coaching and training for staff to improve their personal effectiveness. Staff demonstrated their knowledge and understanding of child protection procedures. We observed that staff understood children's care needs and had good relationships with children and their families.

We are satisfied the provider has met the safeguarding and welfare actions raised. The provider is still registered with Ofsted.
