

Compliance action taken for childcare provision

Summary of outcome

All early years providers must meet the legal requirements in the Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage, which you can find at www.gov.uk/government/publications/early-years-foundationstage-framework--2. If we find that a provider is not meeting the requirements, we can take action to ensure they put matters right.

On 25 April 2024, the provider notified us of a significant event. The notification means that the provider met their legal responsibility as set out in the Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage to notify Ofsted of any significant event which is likely to affect the suitability of the early years provider to look after children.

On 7 May 2024, we carried out a regulatory visit. We found the provider had not been meeting some of the requirements and had taken action to put this right. Individuals had failed to follow the procedures in place when administering medication. The provider took immediate action to investigate the incident. They revised and reissued the procedures for administering medication to all members of staff. They ensured all staff were familiar with new procedures.

On 7 May 2024, we received concerns that the provider was not meeting some of the requirements. On 9 May 2024, we carried out a regulatory telephone call. We discussed the concerns which had been reported. We found that the provider was not meeting some of the requirements. Although risks had been identified in the outdoor area and put aside, these were not immediately removed from the area. The provider has since taken action to ensure all risk assessments have been revisited and any potential risks removed immediately. There is no further action required from Ofsted.

The provider is still registered with Ofsted.

Publication of compliance action

We aim to ensure that the welfare of children and young people is protected in the services we regulate. The Childcare Act 2006 and accompanying regulations set out our responsibilities to regulate childminders and childcare providers. This includes the enforcement powers we have in relation to those registered providers who do not comply with the requirements for registration.

We publish details of any actions we take, or the childminder or childcare provider takes to bring about compliance with requirements on our website for a period of five years.
