

Complaint about childcare provision

Summary of outcome

All early years providers must meet the legal requirements in the Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage, which you can find at www.gov.uk/government/publications/early-years-foundation-stage-framework--2. If we find that a provider is not meeting the requirements, we can take action to ensure they put matters right.

On 12 Jun 2024, we received concerns that the provider was not meeting some of these requirements.

On 4 July 2024, we carried out a regulatory visit. We found the provider was not meeting some of the requirements and had taken action to put this right. This includes providing further training for staff regarding data protection. The setting has updated the policy regarding data protection and ensured that this is read and understood by all staff. The setting has changed the procedures regarding how confidential information is shared, to prevent any further data breaches.

The provider will be able to give parents further information about this. The provider is still registered with Ofsted.
