

Compliance action taken for childcare provision

Summary of outcome

All early years providers must meet the legal requirements in the Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage, which you can find at www.gov.uk/government/publications/early-years-foundation-stage-framework--2. If we find that a provider is not meeting the requirements, we can take action to ensure they put matters right.

On the 23 July 2024, we carried out an inspection and found the provider was not meeting some of these requirements. The report and inspection outcome will be published in due course.

Following the inspection, we served a welfare requirements notice on 24 July 2024. This is a legal notice that requires the provider to take the actions below within the timescales set out. The provider will be able to give parents further information about this.

Action needed by 25 July 2024:

- 1) ensure hazards are identified and managed effectively and promptly, so children are not exposed to risk

Action needed by 6 August 2024

- 1) ensure all staff have the necessary skills to support children's behaviour, to help them to manage their emotions and to learn the impact their actions may have on themselves and others.

On 31 July 2024, we carried out a regulatory visit. The focus of the visit was to check whether the provider had met the safeguarding and welfare action due by 25 July 2024, that were raised at their last inspection.

We found the provider has taken action to remove hazards in the nursery to ensure children are not exposed to risk. This includes removing broken toys, securing the door to a utilities plant room and ensuring items that had been piled up in the corner of the garden to dispose of have been removed. Additionally, the provider has reviewed the layout of the garden area to help children stay safe when using ride on toys.

We are satisfied the provider has met the safeguarding and welfare actions raised that were due by 25 July 2024. We will monitor the provider's response to ensure the actions that are due by 8 August 2024 are successfully completed.

The provider is still registered with Ofsted.
