

Compliance action taken for childcare provision

Summary of outcome

All early years providers must meet the legal requirements in the Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage, which you can find at www.gov.uk/government/publications/early-years-foundation-stage-framework--2. If we find that a provider is not meeting the requirements, we can take action to ensure they put matters right.

On 6 September 2024, we received concerns that the provider was not meeting requirements relating to health, safety and suitability of premises, environment and equipment, and supporting and understanding children's behaviour.

On 10 September 2024, the provider also notified us of these concerns which means that the provider met their legal responsibility as set out in the Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage to notify Ofsted of any significant event which is likely to affect their suitability to look after children.

On 22 October 2024, we carried out a regulatory telephone call. We found the provider was not meeting some of the requirements and had taken action to put this right. The provider has improved risk assessment arrangements and monitors the indoor and outdoor environment throughout the day. The provider has reviewed the routines for children and implemented strategies to help children learn to regulate their behaviour. In addition, they have identified training for staff to further extend their knowledge to support children with additional needs.

The provider will be able to give parents further information about this. The provider is still registered with Ofsted.

Publication of compliance action

We aim to ensure that the welfare of children and young people is protected in the services

we regulate. The Childcare Act 2006 and accompanying regulations set out our responsibilities to regulate childminders and childcare providers. This includes the enforcement powers we have in relation to those registered providers who do not comply with the requirements for registration.

We publish details of any actions we take, or the childminder or childcare provider takes to bring about compliance with requirements on our website for a period of five years.
