

Compliance action taken for childcare provision

Summary of outcome

All early years providers must meet the legal requirements in the Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage, which you can find at www.gov.uk/government/publications/early-years-foundation-stage-framework--2. If we find that a provider is not meeting the requirements, we can take action to ensure they put matters right.

On 7 April 2025, we received concerns that the provider was not meeting requirements relating to safeguarding and welfare.

On 28 April 2025, we carried out a regulatory visit. We found the provider was not meeting some of the requirements. We have served a welfare requirements notice. This is a legal notice that requires the provider to take the actions below within the timescales set out. The provider will be able to give parents further information about this.

Actions needed by 19 May 2025

- ensure all staff effectively implement your policy and procedures to safeguard children, and ensuring they respond to safeguarding concerns about a child in a timely way
- ensure that staff receive effective support to help them understand how to manage children's behaviour appropriately.

On 15 May 2025 the provider responded to the actions set by email. On 27 May 2025 we carried out a monitoring visit. We found the provider had met the actions set. The provider trained all staff on how to manage children's behaviour consistently. The management and staff team reviewed how they record information and updated their knowledge on safeguarding policy and practice

We are satisfied the provider has met the safeguarding and welfare action raised. The provider is still registered with Ofsted.

Publication of compliance action

We aim to ensure that the welfare of children and young people is protected in the services we regulate. The Childcare Act 2006 and accompanying regulations set out our

responsibilities to regulate childminders and childcare providers. This includes the enforcement powers we have in relation to those registered providers who do not comply with the requirements for registration.

We publish details of any actions we take, or the childminder or childcare provider takes to bring about compliance with requirements on our website for a period of five years.
