

## **Compliance action taken for childcare provision**

### **Summary of outcome**

All early years providers must meet the legal requirements in the Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage, which you can find at [www.gov.uk/government/publications/early-years-foundation-stage-framework--2](http://www.gov.uk/government/publications/early-years-foundation-stage-framework--2). If we find that a provider is not meeting the requirements, we can take action to ensure they put matters right.

On 2 June 2025, the provider notified us about matters relating to concerns about children's safety and welfare. The notification means that the provider met their legal responsibility as set out in the Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage to notify Ofsted of accidents and injuries children may have a significant event.

On 16 June 2025, we carried out a regulatory visit. We found the provider was not meeting some of the requirements. Additionally, during the regulatory visit on 16 June 2025, we found a further area of concern also relating to safety and welfare of children. This means that the provider was not meeting other requirements as set out in the Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage.

We have issued actions for the provider to take. The provider will be able to give parents further information about this.

Actions needed by 3 July 2025:

- ensure effective procedures are implemented to check the identity of all visitors to keep children safe
- identify and remove risks to children's safety, to ensure children are not exposed to risks in the environment including when collecting children from other provisions

- ensure all play equipment used by children is fit for purpose and assessed for its suitability for the age and abilities of the children using it, to ensure children's safety
- train all staff to understand the safeguarding policy to ensure they have up-to-date knowledge of safeguarding issues, and they can identify and report concerns that a child may be at the risk of harm
- make sure staff supervise children adequately and children remain within sight or hearing of staff at all times to protect children's safety.

We will monitor the provider's response to ensure the actions are successfully completed. The provider is still registered with Ofsted.

### **Publication of compliance action**

We aim to ensure that the welfare of children and young people is protected in the services we regulate. The Childcare Act 2006 and accompanying regulations set out our responsibilities to regulate childminders and childcare providers. This includes the enforcement powers we have in relation to those registered providers who do not comply with the requirements for registration.

We publish details of any actions we take, or the childminder or childcare provider takes to bring about compliance with requirements on our website for a period of five years.
