

## **Compliance action taken for childcare provision**

### **Summary of outcome**

All early years providers must meet the legal requirements in the 'Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage', which you can find at [www.gov.uk/government/publications/early-years-foundation-stage-framework](http://www.gov.uk/government/publications/early-years-foundation-stage-framework). If we find that a provider is not meeting the requirements, we can take action to ensure they put matters right.

On the 17 June 2025, the provider notified us about matters relating to safeguarding policies and procedures, staff: child ratios and safety and suitability of premises, environment and equipment. The notification means that the provider met their legal responsibility as set out in the Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage to notify Ofsted of significant events.

On 1 July 2025, we carried out a regulatory telephone call. We found the provider was not meeting some of the requirements. We have issued actions for the provider to take within the time scales set out below. The provider will be able to give parents further information about this.

Action needed by 1 July 2025:

- improve staffing arrangements to ensure children's safety, with specific regards to adequate supervision in the garden areas
- implement a rigorous system for risk assessment to ensure all potential hazards are consistently and effectively identified and addressed.

On 9 July 2025, the provider responded to the action set. We found that the provider had reviewed the staffing arrangements in the garden and updated their risk assessment relating to the outside areas and had shared these with staff. We are satisfied the provider has met the safeguarding and welfare action raised. The provider is still registered with Ofsted.

### **Publication of compliance action**

We aim to ensure that the welfare of children and young people is protected in the services we regulate. The Childcare Act 2006 and accompanying regulations set out our responsibilities to regulate childminders and childcare providers. This includes the enforcement powers we have in relation to those registered providers who do not comply

with the requirements for registration.

We publish details of any actions we take, or the childminder or childcare provider takes to bring about compliance with requirements on our website for a period of five years.
