

Compliance action taken for childcare provision

Summary of outcome

All early years providers must meet the legal requirements in the Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage, which you can find at www.gov.uk/government/publications/early-years-foundation-stage-framework--2. If we find that a provider is not meeting the requirements, we can take action to ensure they put matters right.

On 30 September 2025, we carried out an inspection and found the provider was not meeting some of these requirements. The overall effectiveness of the provision was graded inadequate. The inspection report sets out the actions the provider was required to take to meet the requirements.

On 4 November 2025, we carried out a regulatory visit. The focus of the visit was to check whether the provider had met the safeguarding and welfare actions, raised at their last inspection. We found that the provider has ensured that relevant suitability checks will be completed for staff prior to allowing them unsupervised contact with children. Leaders have accessed safer recruitment training and new systems are in place to review evidence of suitability checks. The provider has implemented training programmes for staff to help improve their skills and knowledge. Staff working with babies have accessed training that covers the specific needs of babies. Procedures to ensure that staff understand children's care needs, including times when their key person is not present, are now in place. Leaders now carefully plan staff deployment to ensure that children are cared for by staff that know them well. They monitor the supervision of children and have trained staff to understand the importance of child supervision. Hygiene routines, such as handwashing at appropriate times are now in place and will be monitored by leaders.

We are satisfied the provider has met the safeguarding and welfare actions raised. The provider is still registered with Ofsted.

Publication of compliance action

We aim to ensure that the welfare of children and young people is protected in the services we regulate. The Childcare Act 2006 and accompanying regulations set out our responsibilities to regulate childminders and childcare providers. This includes the enforcement powers we have in relation to those registered providers who do not comply

with the requirements for registration.

We publish details of any actions we take, or the childminder or childcare provider takes to bring about compliance with requirements on our website for a period of five years.
