

Compliance action taken for childcare provision

Summary of outcome

All early years providers must meet the legal requirements in the Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage, which you can find at www.gov.uk/government/publications/early-years-foundation-stage-framework--2. If we find that a provider is not meeting the requirements, we can take action to ensure they put matters right.

On 27 November 2025 and 7 January 2026, the provider notified us about matters relating to safeguarding policies and procedures. The notification means that the provider met their legal responsibility as set out in the Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage to notify Ofsted of significant events.

On 23 December 2025, we received concerns that the provider was not meeting requirements relating to safeguarding policies and procedures, suitable people and special educational needs.

On 27 January 2026, we carried out a regulatory visit. In relation to the concerns regarding safeguarding policies and procedures, suitable people, and special educational needs, we were satisfied that the provider was meeting the requirements. However, we found the provider was not meeting one other requirement. We have issued an action for the provider to take. The provider will be able to give parents further information about this.

Action needed by 10 February 2026:

- ensure that staff fully understand and follow safe sleeping policies and procedures, that are in line with latest government guidelines.

On 10 February 2026, the provider responded to the action set. We found that the provider had updated policies, procedures and risk assessments, to ensure they are fully aligned with the latest government safety guidance. In addition, the provider had delivered staff training and increased leadership oversight, to ensure safe sleeping arrangements are consistently followed. This helps to keep children safe.

We are satisfied the provider has met the safeguarding and welfare actions raised. The provider is still registered with Ofsted.

Publication of compliance action

We aim to ensure that the welfare of children and young people is protected in the services we regulate. The Childcare Act 2006 and accompanying regulations set out our responsibilities to regulate childminders and childcare providers. This includes the enforcement powers we have in relation to those registered providers who do not comply with the requirements for registration.

We publish details of any actions we take, or the childminder or childcare provider takes to bring about compliance with requirements on our website for a period of five years.
