

Compliance action taken for childcare provision

Summary of outcome

All early years providers must meet the legal requirements in the Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage, which you can find at www.gov.uk/government/publications/early-years-foundation-stage-framework--2. If we find that a provider is not meeting the requirements, we can take action to ensure they put matters right.

On 30 July 2025, we received a notification from the provider and on 4 September 2025, and 5 November 2025, we received concerns that the provider was not meeting requirements relating to risk assessment, staff: child ratios, suitable people, safeguarding policies and procedures, concerns about children's safety and welfare, accidents or injury, risk assessments, safety of premises and information and record keeping,

On 27 November 2025, 2 December 2025, and 5 January 2026, we carried out regulatory telephone calls. We found the provider was not meeting some of the requirements and had taken action to put this right. For example, they have put safeguards in place to ensure that references provided for previous employees are accurate and confirm whether they were satisfied with the employee's suitability to work with children, including any substantiated safeguarding concerns. The provider will be able to give parents further information about this.

The provider is still registered with Ofsted.

Publication of compliance action

We aim to ensure that the welfare of children and young people is protected in the services we regulate. The Childcare Act 2006 and accompanying regulations set out our responsibilities to regulate childminders and childcare providers. This includes the enforcement powers we have in relation to those registered providers who do not comply with the requirements for registration.

We publish details of any actions we take, or the childminder or childcare provider takes to bring about compliance with requirements on our website for a period of five years.
