

Complaint about childcare provision

Summary of outcome

All early years providers must meet the legal requirements in the Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage, which you can find at www.gov.uk/government/publications/early-years-foundation-stage-framework--2. If we find that a provider is not meeting the requirements, we can take action to ensure they put matters right.

On 13 January 2026, we received concerns that the provider was not meeting requirements relating to staff: child ratios and changes that must be notified to Ofsted. On 23 February 2026, we carried out a regulatory telephone call. We found the provider was not meeting some of the requirements and had taken action to put this right. The provider had reviewed their entrance procedures for when children are dropped off at the setting to ensure staff appropriately supervise children during these times. The provider failed to notify Ofsted of a significant and event and had improved their understanding of what is reportable to Ofsted. The provider will be able to give parents further information about this. The provider is still registered with Ofsted.
