You told us you thought your school was getting better, and we agree. Like you, we feel that the headteacher has taken exactly the right action to ensure the school improves. Expectations are now high and you must all work hard to make sure this continues.

We particularly liked the new systems for finding out how well you are all doing in your work and for keeping a check on how good the teaching is.
