The visit provided valuable information which will contribute to our national evaluation and reporting. This report, which will be produced in the summer of 2008, will highlight good practice and identify improvements to be made. King Edward VI College's self-assessment and strategic plan points to a college that knows itself very well and has a clear direction of travel. There is a well defined role for the new diplomas in a broad and coherent curriculum.
